



FREE Prescription Savings Card

At Children's Volunteer Health Network (CVHN) we know all too well how families throughout our area struggle with healthcare related issues. CVHN's mission is to improve the health and well-being of children in need. We are always looking for ways to serve the families in our area, so we are promoting this program which helps families and individuals reduce the cost of their prescription drugs.

CVHN has partnered with The United Networks of America, Inc. (UNA) to offer the UNA Rx Card.

CVHN successfully launched this program in the spring of 2010 and is now seeking to distribute it to a wider audience that has not previously known it even existed. UNA is the largest discount Rx card company in the world, and the discounts offered through the UNA RX Card are generally above what other similar discount cards may offer. The UNA Rx Card provides savings as high as 75% on prescription medications (average savings are roughly 30%), and the plan includes most major pharmacy chains Nationwide. The card is available for use by anyone who does not have prescription drug insurance coverage, or those who use prescription medications that aren't covered by insurance. The program is for people of any age, income, or location in the US, and is pre-activated.

The program also includes a variety of discount opportunities on vision and hearing care, eyeglasses and more. It can even be used for pet medications that may require a prescription.

It is as simple as showing your card when you go to pay for your prescriptions at the pharmacy - there's no catch.

The card kills two birds with one stone: you can save money on your prescriptions, and help support a worthy local charity like CVHN. By using this card, not only do you personally save up to 70% off your prescriptions, but for every prescription filled, CVHN receives a contribution from UNA, which goes to support the programs that help kids in our community be healthy and happy.
